

PEAK HOUR EXEMPTION REQUEST APPLICATION PACKET

Application Checklist (all must be checked and submitted for the packet to be complete)

Complete the Peak Hour Exemption Application packet and submit it through [BOE's Customer Service Portal](https://engpermits.lacity.org/public/control.cfm?action=services) (<https://engpermits.lacity.org/public/control.cfm?action=services>) under the appropriate service.

If applicable, a Police Commission Noise Variance is required for what [LAMC 41.40\(a\)](#) and [LAMC 41.40\(c\)](#) defines as "Night Work". Night Work includes 1) 9:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday; 2) before 8:00 a.m. and after 6:00 p.m. on Saturday; 3) all of Sunday; and 4) any National Holiday. Contact the Police Commission at (323) 236-1400 for additional information.

LADOT approved Traffic Management Plan (TMP)/Traffic Control Plan (TCP)/WATCH Traffic Control Plan (WTCP). Failure to provide will result in a denial.

Payment of the Peak Hour Construction Exemption Fee ([LAMC 62.61\(b\).3](#)) and Peak Hour Compliance Fee ([LAMC 62.61\(b\)](#)) only applicable to Excavation U-Permits) is required

- Checks – Made payable to the City of Los Angeles (include a phone number on the "Note" line)
- On-Line Check (no additional fee) or Credit Card (2.7% additional third party fee applies) Processing through BOE's Universal Cashiering online application.

Peak Hour Exemptions are issued for no more than 2 months unless otherwise indicated by on the TMP accepted by LADOT. Extensions are available.
